Ambedkar's thoughts on Indian Democracy, Constitutional Right and Social Justice. The programmer started at 10:30 am with the welcome address by Ms. Pramod kumar. The chief guest of seminar was Mr. Varun Kumar Singh circle officer, shikarpur and special guest Mr. Prem Chand Sharma Police inspector, Shikarpur. From it has emerged a new deity, and the lamp that will be burning in its temple in this land of temples will be seen from all sides of the nation and from distant comers of the world. A new academy of knowledge, a new inspiration for poetry, a new place of pilgrimage and a new opportunity for literature have sprung up.

A seminar on "Right to Information Act" was organized by co-curricular activity committee of SVM Law College, Shikarpur, Bulandshahr. The resource person Ms. Vidhyanjali Singh H.OD./ Assistant professor of CERT Meerut spoke on Right to Information, its need and application procedure to request for any information, time limit to obtain the information, what are the grounds for rejection to obtain the information. She highlighted on different RTI complaints filed by the common people and benefits of such complaints. She also informed the students to use RTI as a tool to empower themselves.

The Right to Information Act, 2005 was enacted with the avowed objective of providing an effective framework for effectuating the Right of Information recognized under Article 19 of the Constitution of India and to provide for setting the practical regime of RTI for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority.



With the expansion of economy, people's quest for right to information has increased and so has the demand for the inspection of record held by the Government departments and various public authorities. Perhaps, because of the apprehensions that the masses may not get alienated, the Government thought it imperative to initiate steps to bridge the gap with the people through the Right to Information Act and ultimately diminish the aura of mystery around the decision-making and functioning of the Government to make people feel that they are an integral part of the Government system or governance, the Indian democracy through the Right to Information Act, 2005, has made



#### **Importance**

The RTI Act, 2005 did not create a new bureaucracy for implementing the law. Instead, it tasked and mandated officials in every office to change their attitude and duty from one of secrecy to one of sharing and openness.

It carefully and deliberately empowered the Information Commission to be the highest authority in the country with the mandate to order any office in the country to provide information as per the provisions of the Act. And it empowered the Commission to fine any official who did not follow the mandate.

Right to information has been seen as the key to strengthening participatory democracy and ushering in people centered governance.

Access to information can empower the poor and the weaker sections of society to demand and get information about public policies and actions, thereby leading to their welfare. It showed an early promise by exposing wrongdoings at high places, such as in the organization of the Commonwealth Games, and the allocation of 2G spectrum and coal blocks.

Right to information opens up government's records to public scrutiny, thereby arming citizens with a vital tool to inform them about what the government does and how effectively, thus making the government more accountable.

Improves decision making by public authority by removing unnecessary secrecy.

#### Challenges

Different types of information is sought which has no public interest and sometimes can be used to misuse the law and harass the public authorities. For example-

To attain publicity by filing RTI

RTI filed as vindictive tool to harass or pressurize the public authority

Because of the illiteracy and unawareness among the majority of population in the country, the RTI cannot be exercised.

Legal Education in the 21st century is witnessing a significant integration of technology, revolutionizing the learning experience for law students. Technological innovations provide access to resources, enhance engagement through webinars and e-learning, and promote inclusivity, ultimately transforming legal education and expanding opportunities for career growth.

#### Teaching Methods in Legal Education:

There are various kinds of Teaching Methods in Legal Education an across the global level. An out of which more specific and prominent methods are as follows:

- 1. Lecture Method
- 2. Case Method
- 3. Problem Method
- 4. Discussion Method
- 5. Simulation and Role Play
- 6. Collaborative Teaching Method
  - 7. Seminar Method
  - 8. Clinical Method
  - 9. Other method



#### Advantages of lecturing method

- 1. Lecture is a passive method of teaching. Lectures are used to convey critical information, history, background, theories and equations.
- 2. Facilitating large-class communication. Large numbers of students get the benefit of gaining information, . Greater teacher control in the classroom,
- 3. An engaging format, which may complement and clarify course material,
- 4. Students listening skills develop
- 5. Help to learn languages and
- 6. Lecturing also permits the dissemination of unpublished or not readily available material.



#### Disadvantages of lecturing method:

- 1. Placing students in a passive (rather than an active) role.
- 2. Grabbing attention of students is very difficult.
- 3. Slow learners face problem in following teaching/lecturing.
- 4. Encouraging one-way communication. The lecturer gives lecture and the students listen but don't interact.
- 5. Requiring significant out-of-class time for students to engage with the material, and
- 6. Lecture methods are constrained to class room teaching only.
- 7. Requiring the speaker to possess effective speaking skills.

#### Types of lecture method:

- Oral also includes face to face lecturing method and online lecturing method.
   Traditional
- 2. Textual/ multimedia includes PPT, CD's.lecture3. Participatory lecture includes debate / group discussions.
- 4. Problem solving. A problem becomes the focus for demonstration and generates various solutions.

The above methods from 1 to 3 come under the category of old traditional method of teaching. Lecture method should be used and is most effective when it presents information which students cannot learn on their own.

#### Steps to be followed in order to deliver good lecture while applying lecture method:

- 1. Know your audience (students, officials, laymen, professionals, workers, housewives. etc.)
- 2. Prepare a map to follow (lecture outline)
- 3. Start the lecture with an introductory topic (grab attention of the audience)
- 4. Recognize audience attention span
- 5. Plan an activity for the audience/ students
- 6. Use attractive way of presentation by way of audio and visual presentation tools
- 7. Have a conclusion, summary at the end of lecture and
- 8. Give assignments/ task for the audience/ students to prepare and come based on the lecture delivered.
